50% Grenache, 45% Shiraz, 5% Mourvèdre
Single Vineyard,
Barossa Valley

Style:

- The “Famous Club” of the three Barossa Valley grapes – **Enjoy it with your club of friends!**
- a harmonious marriage of fruit and spice, medium-bodied, succulent and well-balanced

Tasting Notes:

- Colour: intense purple red
- Nose: red and black berries, spices, a touch of cedarwood
- Palate: a succulent medium-weight palate of sweet red and black berries, plums, earthy and aromatic undertones of rosemary, thyme and black pepper, fine and well integrated tannins

Technical Notes:

- Partly handpicked, as the varieties ripen at different times over a period of several weeks the fermentation is done separately, the final blend assembled together after 6 mths, then further put in barrel
- Barrel aged for 10 mths in 15% new French and American oak, balance older French barriques
- cellar up to 8 years
- 13,5% Alc.Vol., pH 3,59, TA 6,49 g/l

Food Pairings:

- Perfect with Mediterranean cuisine, with grilled or roasted meat, chicken, all pasta dishes with tomatoes
