



THE DANCER Pinot Gris 2018

Thomas Block, McLarenVale - Single Vineyard

biodynamic

Style:

- Fresh and Pure! – Let all aromas dance on your palate – funky fresh and pleasant! French origin and character – a cult wine from cooler climates in Australia since the 1990ies! This biodynamic Dancer always is in balance!

Tasting Notes:

- Colour: vibrant straw with a touch of a copper hue (that's the grape!)
- Nose: subtle floral notes of frangipani, nashi pears, white peach, pine nuts
- Palate: fresh fruit of lemon, grapefruit and gooseberry, creamy and flavoursome mid-palate and a balanced mineral and citrus finish

Technical Notes: Winemaker Richard Freebairn

- Night harvest, whole berry pressed without destemming or crushing, cool fermentation of the juice at 13-16°C in stainless steel to encapsulate fruit freshness
- once fermented, the wine lees were regularly mixed into suspension for 4 weeks to increase complexity and texture
- Filtered and bottled early in its life to capture the freshness of the variety
- Drink young or cellar up to 5 years
- 12,5 % alc./vol. pH 3,08 TA 6,32

Food Pairings:

- Perfect with fish and seafood, white meat, prosciutto, mushrooms, pasta with vegies, asparagus, summer salads, apéritif

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
